On the other hand, public and private transportation are different in more ways than they are **similar**. Cars and bicycles offer a level of privacy and convenience not available in public transport. You can make your own schedule, take a detour and not have to pay fares or deal with people you don't want to be with. **However**, it is only with public one that you can move around, relax and not have to pay attention to traffic or weather conditions.
