The strange light appeared in the sky very suddenly. At first, perhaps for a second, it was very small, like a match being lit in the night. But then it quickly became extremely bright, a hundred times brighter than the sun. Then, just as suddenly, the sea "exploded". There is no other way to describe it.

The roar of the explosion was so loud that it could have been heard on the other side of the world. There were; however, no humans on earth at that time to hear it. It happened 65 million of years ago. The light was a very large and a very heavy meteor which probably weighed into billions of tons. When it broke through the earth's atmosphere and crashed into the sea, the water was changed into a kind of gas and the meteor was like a barrel of fire. How do we know this explosion really happened? And what could have caused it? To answer these two questions, we must first consider another mystery.

About two hundred years ago, the first fossils, or bones of a huge prehistoric animal were found. Scientists studied the bones and discovered that it was a kind of reptile. They called this reptile a dinosaur. "They also discovered that these giant animals lived on the earth for millions of years but then suddenly, and perhaps as the result of a catastrophe, disappeared.

Below the ground there are many different layers of rock and clay. Each period of the earth's history has a particular layer. The bones of dinosaurs are found in one layer. Then there is a thin layer of clay. In the next layer after this, we find the bones of different kinds of animals, but no more dinosaurs.

There something very strange about the thin layers of clay between the bones of the dinosaurs and the bones of the animals that came after them. This thin layer of clay is very rich in two very unusual metals called osmium and iridium. Certain types of meteors contain large amounts of iridium and osmium. The concentrations of these metals in that thin layer or clay might have come from such a meteor, the largest and heaviest that has ever hit the earth. It could have had the energy of 5 billion atomic bombs of the size that was dropped on Nagasaki in August 1945.

This explosion could have caused a long period of darkness. The sun rose and set each day as before, but its rays were unable to penetrate through the cloud of gas that covered the earth. This period of darkness might have lasted as long as 5 years. Millions of animals would have died and, for various reasons, large animals that lived on the land would have suffered the most. The dinosaur was just one of the animals that disappeared in perhaps the greatest catastrophe that has ever taken place on this earth.
