Useful Vocabulary

- * Use phrases like:
Would you like to ...? Can you come to ...?
Why don't you come to ...?
- * Use vocabulary relating to sports:
play football/basketball/volleyball/tennis,
go to the gym, exercise
- * Use phrases like:
after that, then, next, finally, after the tennis,
after the gym, afterwards

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Ask Jane if she would like to come to the sports centre on Saturday/Sunday...
- Tell her what you can do there.
- Say that you will do something nice afterwards, for example, you will meet friends or go to a café.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 31

Jane,

Would you like to come to the sports centre on Saturday? I thought maybe we could play tennis together. There is a tennis coach too and he's very good. After that, we can go to the café there. They make very nice coffee.

Useful Vocabulary

- * Use words relating to talking:
talk about (a problem), discuss (a problem),
decide (to do something)
- * Use words and phrases relating to dogs and their food:
be/feel hungry, be/feel happy, buy dog food,
give food to the dogs

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Give the boys names and say what they were talking about. Explain why.
- Then, say what the boy in picture 2 bought.
- Finally say what the boys did in picture 3 and how the dogs felt.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 32

Peter and John were talking about some dogs that are hungry in their neighbourhood. Then Peter bought some dog food from a shop. One hour later, Peter and John gave food to the hungry dogs. The dogs were very happy.
