Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Say that her mother came into her room. Explain the problem.
- Say why the girl had to stay in.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 32

Jane was talking on the phone with her friend Vicky. Vicky invited her to go to the cinema. Then Jane's mum was in her room. She was holding Jane's test. She was shouting at her because she got a bad mark. She probably told Jane that she couldn't go out. Then Jane stayed at home and she did her homework.
