Writing Tips for Part 6

- Read the instructions carefully.
- Look at **WHAT TYPE** of message you are sending.
- Make sure **WHO** you will send the message to.
- Look at **WHAT** you need to put in the message and think about what you are going to say.
- You must write some text for **ALL THREE** instructions.
- Write your message on a different piece of paper and when you are happy with it, write it on your answer sheet.

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Ask Peter to join the art club.
- Tell him the reason you want him to go with you.
- Tell him what things/activities you will learn.
- Tell Peter who is taking you back home.

SAMPLE ANSWER - Question 31

Hi Peter,

I know that you wanted to start a new hobby. You can come to the after-school art club with me on Monday. We can learn how to draw cars and bicycles. Also, my mother will drive you home after the club.

Let me know what you think.

Writing Tips for Part 7

- Read the instructions carefully.

- Write your ideas on a different piece of paper before writing on the answer sheet.

Suggested Structure & Writing Ideas

- Start with what you are doing in the first picture and what you have in your hands.
- Write about what is happening in the second picture. Where are you and where are your books?
- Write what is happening in the third picture. What is the teacher saying to you? Is she angry with you? And why?
