DOWN

I must the number of sweets I eat.

- 2) I'm really excited about the holiday.
LOOKING

I the holiday.

- 3) They discussed the situation but nobody had a solution.
CAME

They discussed the situation but a solution.

- 4) Does Malena have a good relationship with her parents?
ON

Does Malena her parents?



- 5) The boss won't tolerate you being late any longer.
PUT

The boss won't..... your tardiness any longer

- 6) I wanted to buy a brand-new iPhone, but the store didn't have any in stock.
RUN



The store hadbrand-new iPhones so I couldn't buy one.

- 7) Getting over a divorce can take some time.
RECOVER

It can take a while to a divorce.
