You should by now have enough confidence to make formal drawings of various views, isometric drawings and orthographic projections.

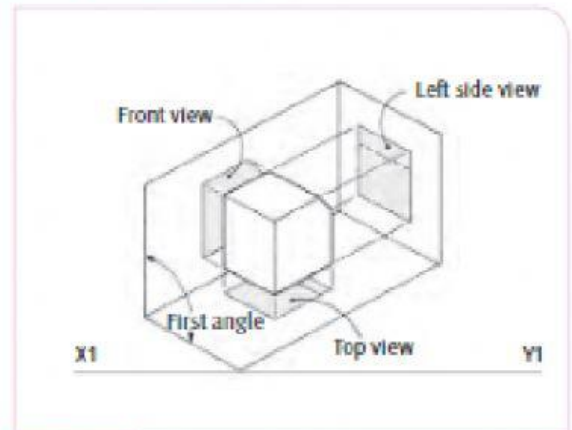


FIGURE 14 A first angle orthographic projection

- height: 40 mm.

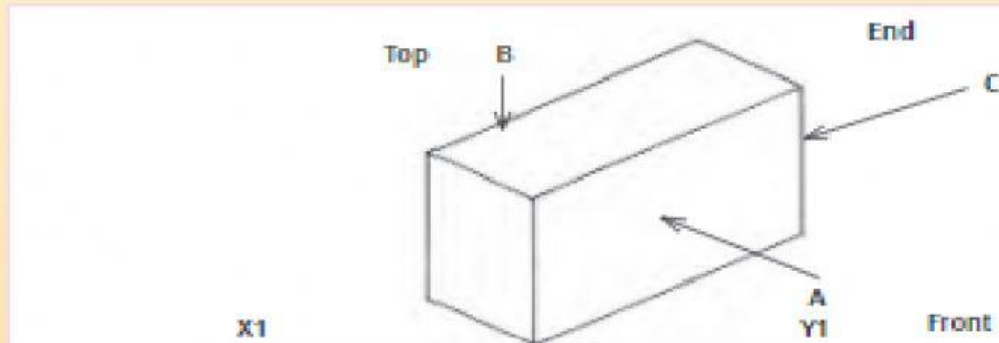


FIGURE 15 Guidelines for your first angle orthographic projection drawings

Use your drawing instruments to draw the following views:

- 1 the front view as seen from direction A.
- 2 plan or top view, as seen from direction B.
- 3 the right side view as seen from direction C.
