### AFFIRMATIVE

I **am**  
You **are**  
He/She/It **is**  
We/You/They **are**

### NEGATIVE

I **am not**  
You **aren't**  
He/She/It **isn't**  
We/You/They **aren't**

### INTERROGATIVE

**Am** I?  
**Are** you?  
**Is** he/she/it?  
**Are** we/you/they?

I am = I'm

You are = You're

They are = They're

She is = She's

He is = He's

It is = It's
