Read about Nurse Saleha and answer the questions

Saleha is a nurse. She works in a big hospital in town. *She gets up at half past five in the morning.* She has a shower and puts on her uniform. She drives to the hospital. She arrives at seven o'clock. She is never late for work!

Nurse Saleha works in the children's ward. She always says 'Hello' to each child when she arrives at work. At half past eight the doctor comes into the ward. He looks at each of the children. He gives them medicine if they feel ill.

The children have their lunch at twelve o'clock. Saleha feeds the children if they are too young to feed themselves. Then she washes the children and puts them back into their beds to sleep.

At half past four in the afternoon, it is time to go home. Saleha says 'Goodbye' to the children. Then she gets in her car and drives home.

She watches television or reads a book. Then she goes to bed early because she is very tired.

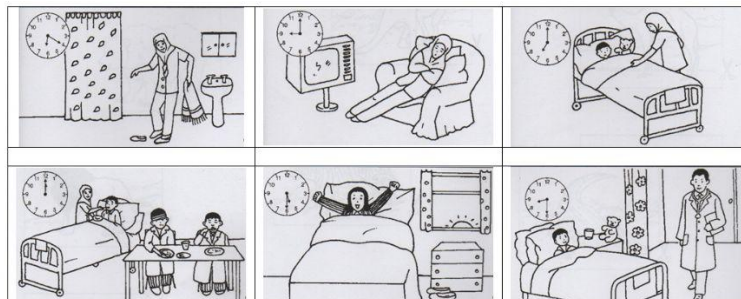
2. Who comes into the ward at half past eight?
