

Gerund or Infinitive?

Some verbs are always followed by a **gerund** (admit, avoid, quit...)

Other verbs are always followed by an **infinitive** (want, allow, expect...)

There are verbs that can be followed either by a gerund or an infinitive **WITHOUT CHANGE IN MEANING**:

Begin - start - continue - like - love - prefer - hate - can't stand - can't bear

Example: "It **began to rain/raining** as soon as we left"

Other verbs can be followed either by a gerund or an infinitive **WITH CHANGE IN MEANING**:

Remember/forget + infinitive (a task, duty, responsibility)

* "Don't forget **to lock** the door"

Remember/forget + gerund (recall something from the past)

* "I remember **meeting** Steve Jobs when I was 16"

Regret + infinitive (to tell, inform of bad news...)

* "I regret **to tell** you that your flight has been cancelled"

Regret + gerund (regret a past event)

* "I'll always regret **not accepting** that job"

Stop + infinitive (stop an action to do something else)

* "I stopped the car **to use** the mobile phone"

Stop + gerund (not longer doing something)

* "She stopped **talking** to me when she knew I had been given her former job."
