_____ The Taj Mahal was built about 400 years ago in India. The **Emperor** Shah Jahan built it for his wife, Mumtaz Mahal. She died when she had her 14th baby. Shah Jahan was very sad, so he built the Taj Mahal to remember his wife. When Shah Jahan died, people put his **corpse** in the Taj Mahal so that he was with his wife forever.

_____ The Taj Mahal looks like a palace, but it is a tomb. It's one of the most beautiful tombs in the world. There are gardens and **fountains** around the building.

_____ The tomb is made of 28 types of stone and jewel from all over India and other countries. Most of the tomb is made of a beautiful stone called **marble**. About 20,000 people built the Taj Mahal, and it took 22 years. More than 1,000 elephants helped to move the stones for the building.
