

SECOND CONDITIONALS

TASK: Read the sentences and fill in the blanks to make second conditional sentences. There is an example for you.

*Example: If I **watered** my flowers, they **wouldn't die**.*

*They **wouldn't die** if I **watered** my flowers.*

1. If you (tell) me a secret, I (keep) it forever.
I (keep) it forever if you (tell) me a secret.

2. If she (go) the dentist, she (be) healthy now.
She (be) healthy now if she (go) the dentist.

3. If Ronaldo (direct) a football team, that team (win) all the medals.
That team (win) all the medals if Ronaldo (direct) a football team.

4. If mum (not prepare) the sandwiches, you (feel) hungry now.
You (be) hungry now if mum (not prepare) the sandwiches.

5. Mike (not stay) in the hospital now if he (complete) his vaccination process.
If he (complete) his vaccination process, Mike (not stay) in the hospital now.

6. If you (read) the instructions carefully, you (answer) the questions correctly.
You would (answer) the questions correctly if you (read) the instructions carefully.

7. I (get) a driver's license if I (be) older.
If I (be) older, I (get) a driver's license.

8. If it (not rain), Jimmy (go) for a walk.
Jimmy (go) for a walk if it (not rain).

9. I (drive) very fast if I (be) an F1 driver.
If I (be) an F1 driver, I (drive) very fast.

10. George (not take) the bus if he (have) a car.
If he (have) a car, George (not take) the bus.
