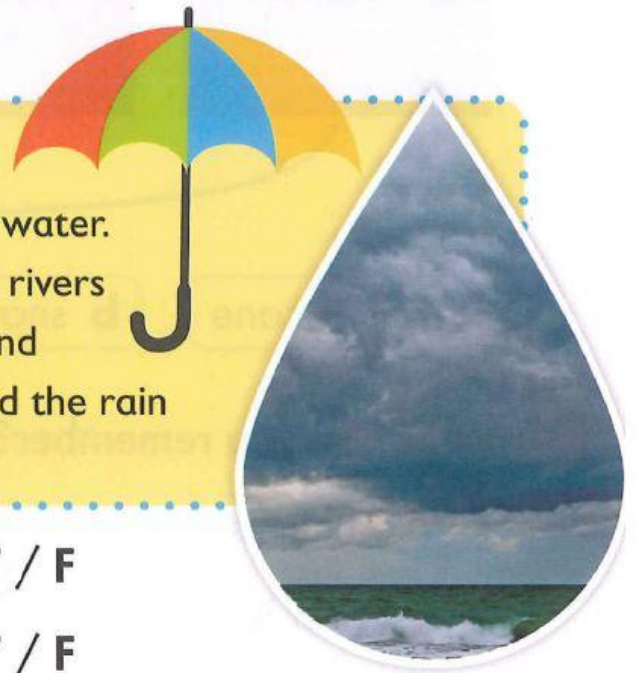

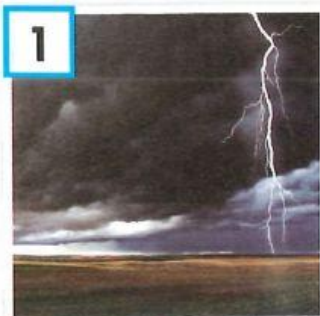
**Where does rain come from?**
