Let's review Comparatives:

Short adjectives ...	Spelling rules	Examples
Usually	+ er	slow → slower fast → faster tall → taller
Ending in -e	+ r	large → larger nice → nicer
Some two-syllable adjectives, especially ending in -y	-y → -i + er	hungry → hungrier happy → happier funny → funnier
Ending in a vowel + a consonant	double the consonant + er	big → bigger fat → fatter fit → fitter

You can use some short adjectives + er + than to compare 2 people, 2 places, 2 animals, 2 things.



Ana is **taller** than Toni.

Toni is **shorter** than Ana.

Ana is **thinner** than Toni.

Toni is **younger** than Ana.



• When the adjective is monosyllabic and ends in one vowel + one consonant we double the last consonant big- bigger hot- hotter

• When the adjective ends in consonant + y, this changes to i before adding -er easy - easier happy - happier
