What's the weather like today? It's raining! How does it rain?

Sun and water make rain. The sun is hot in the sky. It takes the water from the seas, lakes and rivers into the sky. The water makes clouds. Then the weather is cloudy. There are lots of small raindrops in clouds. When there's lots of water in a cloud, the raindrops get bigger and start falling from the cloud. They fall back down onto the mountains and onto the towns. That's rain! Look up at the sky. Is it raining now? Don't forget your umbrella!

- There are two things that make (*rain/ snow*) – sun and water.
- The sun takes (*salt/ water*) from the seas.
- There are (*small raindrops/ big raindrops*) inside clouds.
- If there's (*some/ lots of*) of water in a cloud, then it rains.
