Multiplication is COMMUTATIVE

This means numbers can be multiplied in any order.

$$3 \times 10 \times 5 = 3 \times 5 \times 10$$

We can rearrange the order in which we multiply to make combinations that are easier to multiply.

Is it easier to solve $3 \times 10 \times 6$

or

Is it easier to solve $3 \times 6 \times 10$

Multiplication can be done in an order.
