A Venice Biennale

The first one was in 1895 so this is an old festival and it happens every two years in Venice, Italy. The 53rd one was in 2009 and it was very exciting. Thousands of people come from all over the world. There's theatre, dance, art, cinema and music, so there really is something for everyone. It's very, very crowded so this is not for you if you don't like lots of people!

B Carnival in Rio

Come to Brazil and celebrate the carnival. The first carnival was in the 1930s and now it happens every year. The celebration starts on Sunday evening and finishes on Monday morning. The colours and dancers are absolutely fantastic. The atmosphere is great and everyone is dancing in the streets. There is nothing like it anywhere else in the world.

C Montreux Jazz Festival

The first festival was in 1967 and every year it gets better and better! Montreux is on Lake Geneva in Switzerland and for about two weeks in July, over 200,000 music lovers go there to listen to the music. It was originally a jazz festival but now all kinds of musicians and bands play there.

D Bulgarian Rose Festival

The first rose festival was in 1903 in Kazanlak, the centre of the rose growing region of Bulgaria. Now thousands of people gather at the beginning of June every year to celebrate this beautiful flower. There are lots of things to see and do, all connected with the rose and at the end of the festival there is a new 'Queen of Roses'.

E Salisbury International Arts Festival

For two and a half weeks, the small city of Salisbury in south-west England becomes a centre for international performers: actors, dancers, artists and musicians. The first festival was in 1973 and it takes place every May and June. This year the themes were India and water and there were lots of interesting things to learn.
