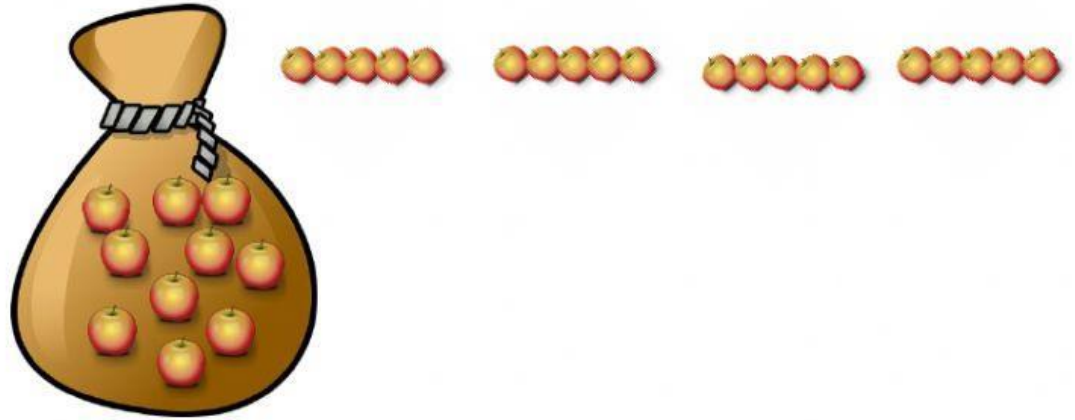


Word problems by grouping and sharing up to 30

1. Linda has 30 apples. She wants to sell her apples in bags of 10. How many bags will she need?



2. Tom has 5 bags of oranges. Each bag has 4 oranges. How many orange are there all together?
3. Susan wants to buy 20 pears. The shop is selling 5 pears per bag. How many bags does she need to make 20?
4. Jordan is selling mangoes. He has 25 mangoes and 5 bags. How many mangoes can he share equally in the bags?
