

Past Progressive “Wh” Questions

Another way to form questions in the past progressive is to add a question word to the beginning of the sentence. The “was” or “were” still moves in front of the subject.

Ex: **What** was Martin reading?
Why was Joseph running late?
Where was Cassie going?
When was Ruben sleeping?
How were they driving?
Who was calling me all night?
