12-1 Adjective Clauses: Introduction

Giới thiệu về mệnh đề tính từ.

Adjectives (<i>Tính từ</i>)	Adjective Clauses (<i>Mệnh đề tính từ</i>)
An adjective modifies a noun. Modify means to change a little. An adjective describes or gives information about the noun. (See Chart 6-8, p. 160.) <i>Tính từ đóng vai trò bổ nghĩa cho danh từ. Tính từ thường miêu tả hoặc bổ sung thêm thông tin cho danh từ. (Xem lại bảng 6-8, trang 160)</i>	An adjective clause modifies a noun. It describes or gives information about a noun. <i>Một mệnh đề tính từ đóng vai trò bổ nghĩa cho danh từ. Nó miêu tả hoặc bổ sung thông tin cho danh từ</i>
An adjective usually comes in front of a noun. <i>Tính từ thường đứng trước danh từ</i>	An adjective clause follows a noun. <i>Mệnh đề tính từ thường theo sau danh từ.</i>
(a) I met a kind man Adjective + noun (b) I met a famous man Adjective + noun	(c) I met a man who is kind to everybody. Noun + adjective clause (d) I met a man who is famous poet. Noun + adjective clause (e) I met a man who lives in Chicago Noun + adjective clause

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Giải nghĩa thuật ngữ ngữ pháp

(1) I met a man = an independent clause; it is a complete sentence. (2) He lives in Chicago = an independent clause; it is a complete sentence. (3) who lives in Chicago = a dependent clause; it is NOT a complete sentence (4) I met a man who lives in Chicago = an independent clause + a dependent clause; a complete sentence	A clause is a structure that has a subject and a verb. There are two kinds of clauses: Independent and dependent. • An independent clause is a main clause and can stand alone as a sentence, as in (1) and (2). • A dependent clause, as in (3), cannot stand alone as a sentence. It must be connected to an independent clause, as in (4).
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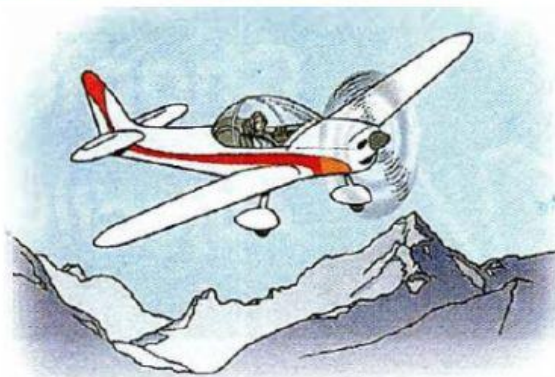
	Mệnh đề là một cấu trúc gồm một chủ ngữ+ một động từ. Có hai dạng mệnh đề: độc lập và phụ thuộc. • Mệnh đề độc lập là một mệnh đề chính và có thể đứng một mình như là một câu như ở ví dụ (1) và (2). • Mệnh đề phụ thuộc, như ở ví dụ (3), không thể đứng một mình như là một câu hoàn chỉnh. Nó phải liên kết với một mệnh đề độc lập khác, như ở ví dụ (4).

12-2 Using Who and That in Adjective Clauses to Describe People

Dùng "Who" và "That" trong mệnh đề tính từ để miêu tả người

(a) The man is friendly

S V
He lives next to me.

↓
who

↓
S V
who lives next to me.

In adjective clauses, **who** and **that** are used as subject pronouns to describe people.

In (a): **He** is a subject pronoun. **He** refers to "the man."

(b) The man who lives next to me is friendly

To make an adjective clause, change **he** to **who**. **Who** is a subject pronoun. **Who** refers to "the man."

*Trong mệnh đề tính từ, **who** và **that** được sử dụng như là đại từ chủ ngữ để miêu tả người. Ở ví dụ (a): **He** là đại từ chủ ngữ. **He** ám chỉ "nam giới".*

*Để đặt một mệnh đề tính từ, đổi **he** thành **who**. **Who** là một đại từ chủ ngữ. **Who** ám chỉ đến chủ ngữ là "nam giới".*

(c) The woman is talkative.

She	lives next to me.

that	lives next to me.

That is also a subject pronoun and can replace **who**, as in (d).

The subject pronouns **who** and **that** cannot be omitted from an adjective clause.

***That** cũng là một đại từ chủ ngữ và có thể thay thế **who**, như ở ví dụ (d).*

*Hai đại từ chủ ngữ **who** và **that** không thể bị lược bỏ trong mệnh đề tính từ.*

INCORRECT: The woman lives next to me is talkative.

As subject pronouns, both **who** and **that** are common in conversation, but **who** is more common in writing.

*Với vai trò là đại từ chủ ngữ, cả **who** và **that** rất phổ biến trong các đoạn hội thoại, nhưng **who** lại phổ biến hơn trong văn viết.*

(d) The woman that lives next to me is talkative.

In (b) and (d): The adjective clause immediately follows the noun it modifies.

Ở ví dụ (b) và (d): mệnh đề tính từ đi ngay sau danh từ mà nó bổ nghĩa.

INCORRECT: The woman is talkative that lives next to me.

12-3 Using Object Pronouns in Adjective Clauses to Describe People

Sử dụng đại từ tân ngữ trong mệnh đề tính từ để miêu tả người

(a) The man was friendly

In adjective clauses, pronouns are used as the object of a verb to describe people.

In (a): **him** is an object pronoun. **Him** refers to "the man."

One way to make an adjective clause is to change **him** to **that**. **That** is the object

O S V (b) The man that I met was friendly. (c) The man X I met was friendly	pronoun. That refers to “the man.” That comes at the beginning of an adjective clause. An object pronoun can be omitted from an adjective clause, as in (c). <i>Trong mệnh đề tính tuwg, đại từ được dùng như tân ngữ của động từ để tả người.</i> <i>Ở ví dụ (a): him là một đại từ tân ngữ. S V (d) The man was friendly. I met O him ↓ whom who O S V (e) The man who I met was friendly. (f) The man whom I met was friendly.	Him can also be changed to who or whom, as in (e) and (f). As an object pronoun, that is more common than who in speaking. X is the most common choice for both speaking and writing. Whom is generally used only in very formal writing. <i>Him cũng có thể được biến đổi thành who hoặc whom, như ở ví dụ (e) và (f).</i> <i>Với vai trò là một đại từ tân ngữ, that được sử dụng phổ biến trong giao tiếp hơn who. Tuy nhiên thì đa phần người nói sẽ lược bỏ who và whom cả trong văn nói lẫn văn viết.</i> <i>Whom thường được sử dụng trong các văn bản hành chính, văn bản có văn phong trang trọng.</i>
