## A Special Meal

Thailand is a country in Southeast Asia. It is a very popular place to visit for people from other countries. About 38 million people went there in 2018. Many people like to visit Thailand because it has a lot of beautiful beaches and temples. It has some interesting festivals, too. One is called the Monkey Buffet Festival in the city of Lopburi.

The Monkey Buffet Festival is not a traditional festival. Because of this, it is different from other festivals in Thailand. Lopburi started the festival because the city wanted more visitors. During this festival, a lot of fruit and vegetables are put on tables near an old temple. However, the food is not for visitors. It is for monkeys that live near the temple.

In Thailand, monkeys are a symbol of good luck. There is a traditional story in Thailand about a prince named Rama. In the story, Rama tries to save his wife from a demon king.\* A monkey king named Hanuman and his monkeys help Rama. The people in Lopburi wanted to make a festival for visitors, but they wanted to thank Hanuman, too. To remember the monkey king, food is given to monkeys during the festival.

At the beginning of the festival, performers wear monkey costumes and dance. Then they uncover\* the food, and over 2,000 monkeys from the area come to eat it. The visitors enjoy watching the monkeys. However, they should be careful because these monkeys sometimes take people's bags and other things.
