★ Look at the picture of this happy family! a. Ask the question to know their ['ðeər] age and b. Answer: write their complete ages [iz] in letters. Regarde l'image de cette heureuse famille! a. Pose la question pour connaître leur âge b. Réponds en indiquant leur âge en entier en lettres.

→ Help! SOS! = Use ['ju:s] She is ( for a girl or a woman) ...years old / He is... ( for a boy or a man) / It is ... quand le sujet est considéré neutre. Utilise



1. Jane (Mum/mother) 2. Roy (Dad/father) 3. Mary (the daughter) 4. Liz (Grand-Mother) 5. Luke (the son) 6. Vincent (Grand-Father) 7. Archie (the fat cat!)

Examples 1. a. Question : How old is Jane (Mum)? b. Ans(w)er : She is **thirty-five (35) (years old)** = Elle "a" 35 ans → Elle est âgée de 35 ans

2. Q: How old is Roy (Dad) ? A: He is **forty (40) years old**.

3. Q: How \_\_\_\_\_ is their **daughter** ['dɔ:tər'], Little Mary? A: S\_\_\_\_\_ is f\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ (5 ½ years old)

4. Q: \_\_\_\_\_ old is Grand-Ma' Liz? A: \_\_\_\_\_ - one (61 years o\_\_\_\_\_ )

5. Q: \_\_\_\_\_ is their **son**['sən] Luke? A: He is n\_\_\_\_\_ (or a\_\_\_\_\_ ) (12 → 13 years old) *il a presque...*

6. Q: \_\_\_\_\_ Grand Pa' Vincent? A: \_\_\_\_\_ - (88 \_\_\_\_\_ old )

7. Q: \_\_\_\_\_ is Archie, the children's fat cat? A: He or \_\_\_\_\_ is \_\_\_\_\_ (9 m\_\_\_\_\_ old). It's a male! /ei/ it's not a female /'fi:meil/.
