Will + infinitive

A decision at the moment of speaking.

Boy: There is no milk.

Girl: Really? I will go and buy some!

A prediction based on opinion.

Madrid will win the match, they are the best.

A future fact.

The sun will rise in the east tomorrow.

For promises, requests, refusals, and offers.

I will help you tomorrow, if you like.

Be going to + infinitive

A decision BEFORE the moment of speaking.

Boy: There is no milk.

Girl: I know. I am going to buy some.

A prediction based on something we can see or hear now.

I think Real Madrid is going to win the match, they are ahead by 3 points.
