

## Language Tip – Using ‘Will’ and ‘Going To’

There are some general rules we can follow to decide if we should use 'will' or 'going to' to express the future

## We use will to talk about facts:

*We will never cross this line*

**We use will when we are making an instant decision**

*This food is ready, I'll place it on the wooden board*

## We use 'going to' to make predictions

*As we are outside I think it's going to be safe*

## We use 'going to' to make plans

*We're going to use a long wooden board*
