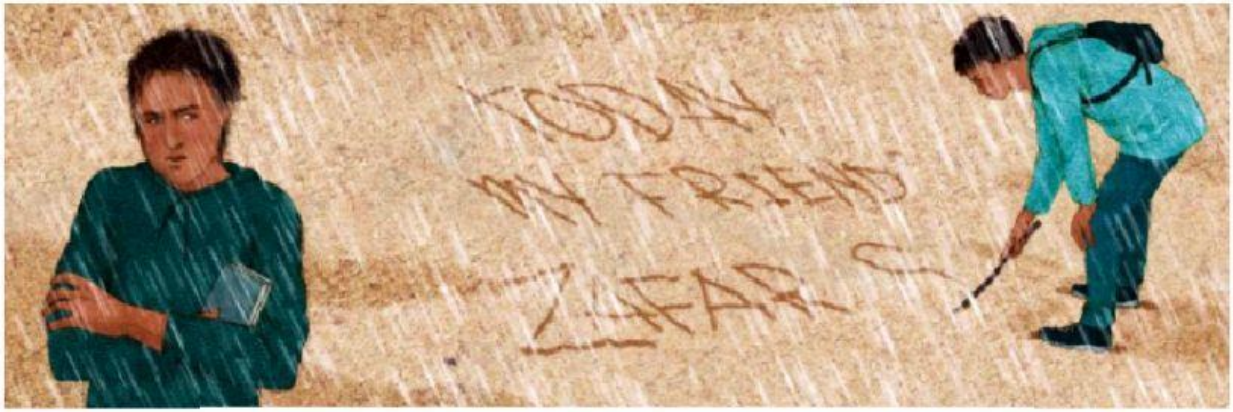




A LESSON IN FRIENDSHIP
