Simple Subject and Simple Predicate

The simple subject is the main noun located in the subject part of the sentence.

Example: The students of grade six went on a field trip.

Simple subject - **students**

The simple predicate is the verb in the predicate part of the sentence.

Simple predicate - **went**

EXCEPTIONS

1. John Hall is the best chef in the world.

In this example, John Hall is the simple subject and the complete subject.

Simple predicate will be **is sleeping**.
