We often use **will / won't + infinitive** for future predictions, to say things we think, guess or know about the future.


For example: She will be late.

We can use short answers for questions about the future.

For example: - Will be there ice rinks in the future? → Yes, there will → No, there won't
- Will you go to the university in the future? → Yes, I will → No, I won't
