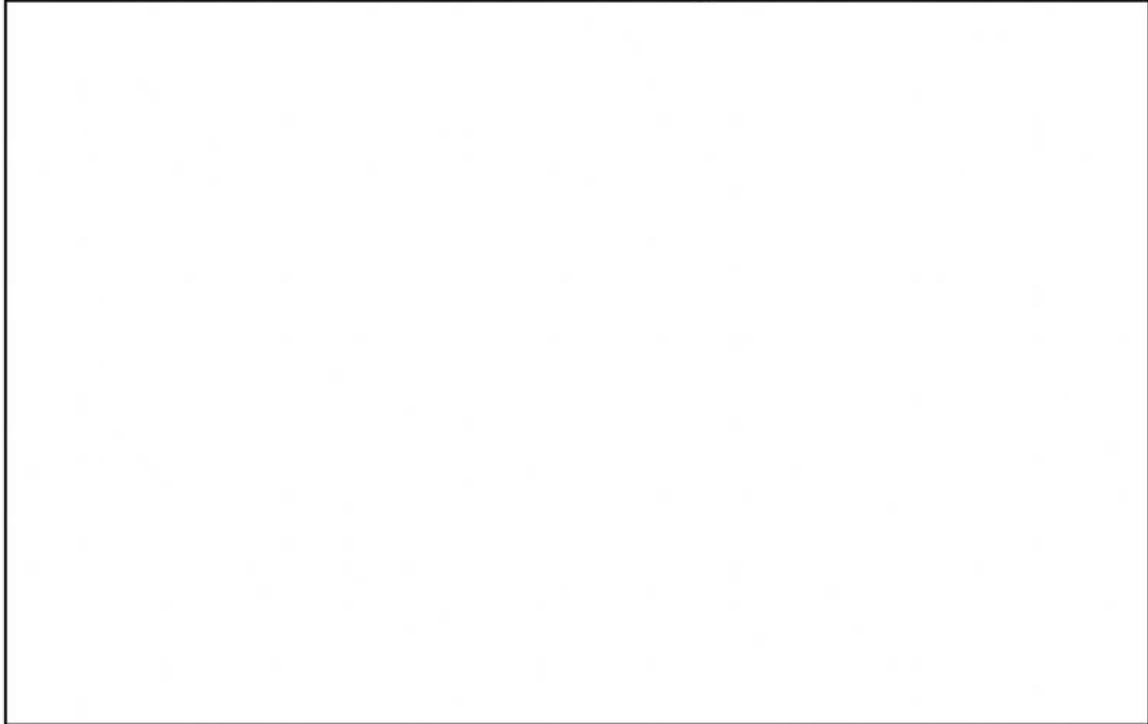


Pip the Dog
