4 Types of Sentences

Declarative Sentence

- Tells something.
- Ends with a period. (.)

Interrogative Sentence

- Asks a question.
- Ends with a question mark. (?)

Exclamatory Sentence

- Shows strong feeling.
- Ends with an exclamation mark. (!)

Imperative Sentence

- Gives a command.
- Ends with a period or an exclamation mark. (.) or (!)
