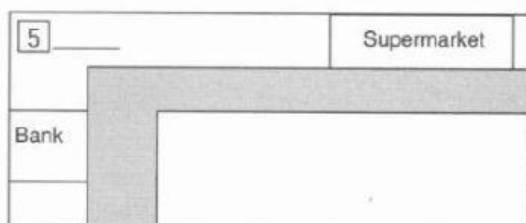
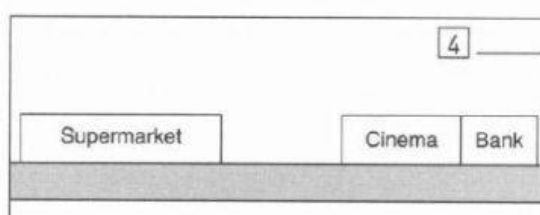
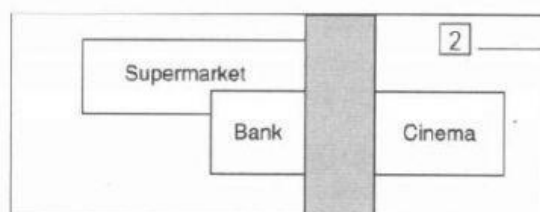
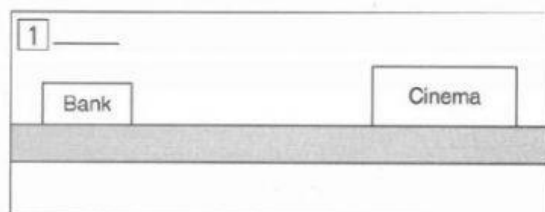


Exam information: Labelling a map or plan (2)

In the IELTS Listening exam, the maps and plans are usually very simple, with some parts labelled. You should use the labelled parts as a guide when listening.



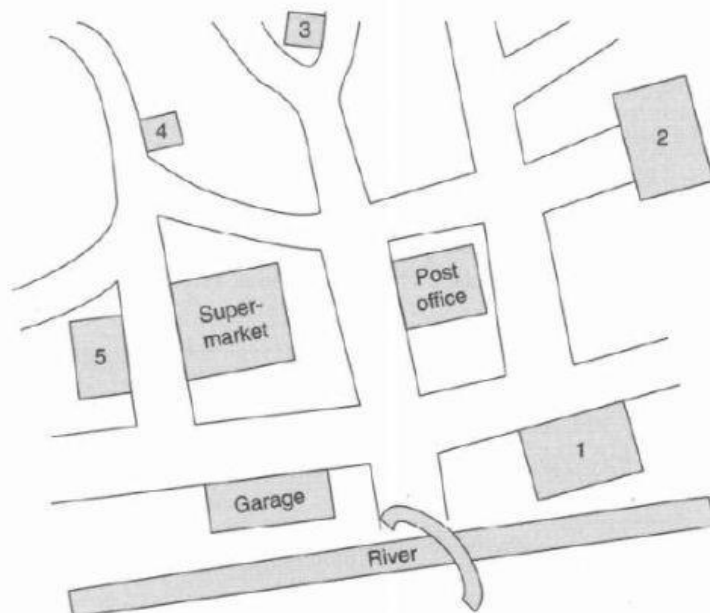
- 3 Listen and match the pictures 1–5 with the sentences you hear a–e. Write the letters a–e next to the question numbers 1–5.

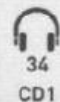
