

Stanza	It does not follow any special rules of organization or arrangement.
Free verse	Repetition of vowels within a word.
Couplet	The way the poem is arranged.
Mood	Describe the writer's emotion/attitude towards the topic he/she is writing about.
Form	Repetition of consonants (not vowels) at the beginning of words.
Assonance	Two lines in a poem that have similar length and rhyming pattern.
Tone	Repetition of sound at the ends of words.
Alliteration	Say something indirectly
Rhyme	A division of a poem consisting of a series of lines arranged together.
Euphemism	General feelings/emotions that readers get upon reading a particular poem.
