Pay attention to the expression: "Cause havoc"



Havoc, in modern use, typically carries such meanings as "wide and general destruction," or "great confusion and disorder."

"**Cry Havoc!**" (and let slip the dogs of war") today is used in the sense "to sound an alarm."

havoc can be **played, caused, raised, or made**, meaning "to do great damage to" or "to throw into disorder and confusion." These

uses are more commonly found in British English.

Americans are likelier to use **wreak havoc**.

The verb **wreak** usually means "bring about, cause"

Red-hot 1 from a volcano on Spain's La Palma Island has entered the sea sending 2 of steam into the air. The eruption has caused 3 on the island for the last nine days, destroying houses and 4 . Spain's government has declared the island a 5 and will 6 millions of euros in 7 to those 8 . After nine days of slow 9 , the lava from 10 Cumbre Vieja meets the Atlantic Ocean. 11 erupts from the water potentially sending 12 of 13 into the air. 14 are urging the public to stay away. 15 rock has been flowing down the volcano's western 16 for over a week, 17 hundreds of houses and 18 .
