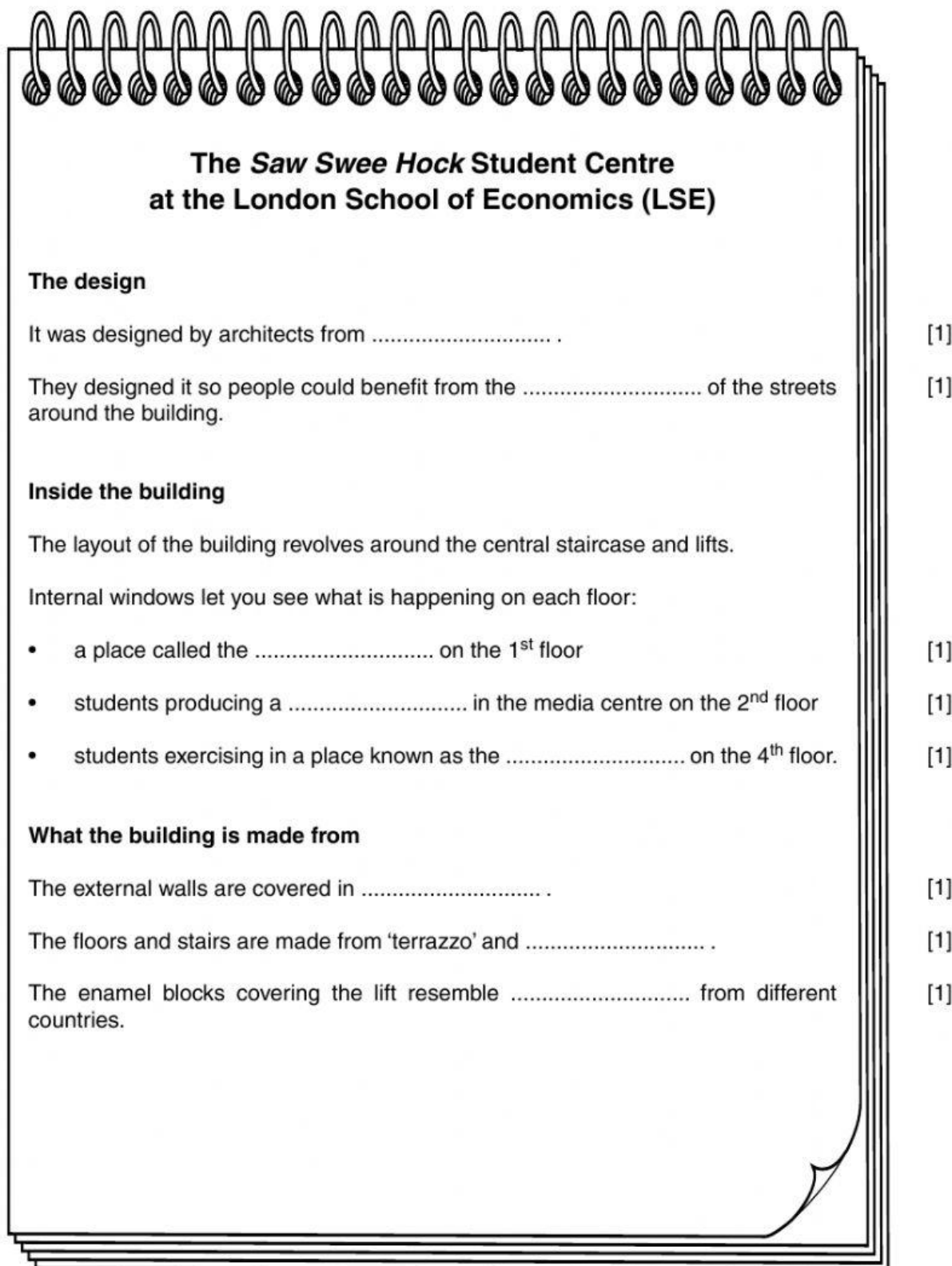


Question 5
