

Here, citizens of the country can run for public office and the people get to decide who is in charge of the government.	ANARCHY
Here, a single individual has gained power through force and everyone has to follow his policies.	MONARCHY
Here, there is one head of state, a king or a queen, who rules the country for as long as they are alive. The crown is passed on, usually to the first born of the family.	DICTATORSHIP
Here, a religious institution holds power over the king.	REPUBLIC
Here, a single group has control of the country for decades. The regime maintains complete control of the country by not allowing any other people to form a political party.	THEOCRACY
Here, people are elected to government office by voters. It is however, headed by a single individual whose office is also elected by the people.	TOTALITARIAN
Here, there is no functioning government	DEMOCRACY
