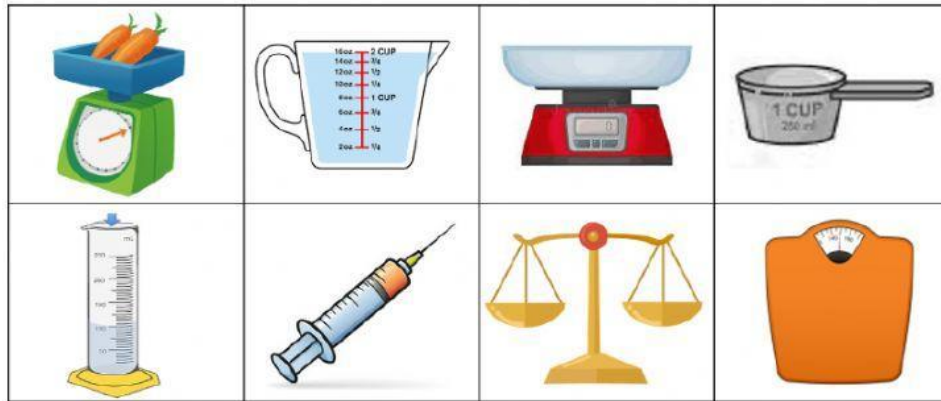


Mass, Volume and Measuring Tools
