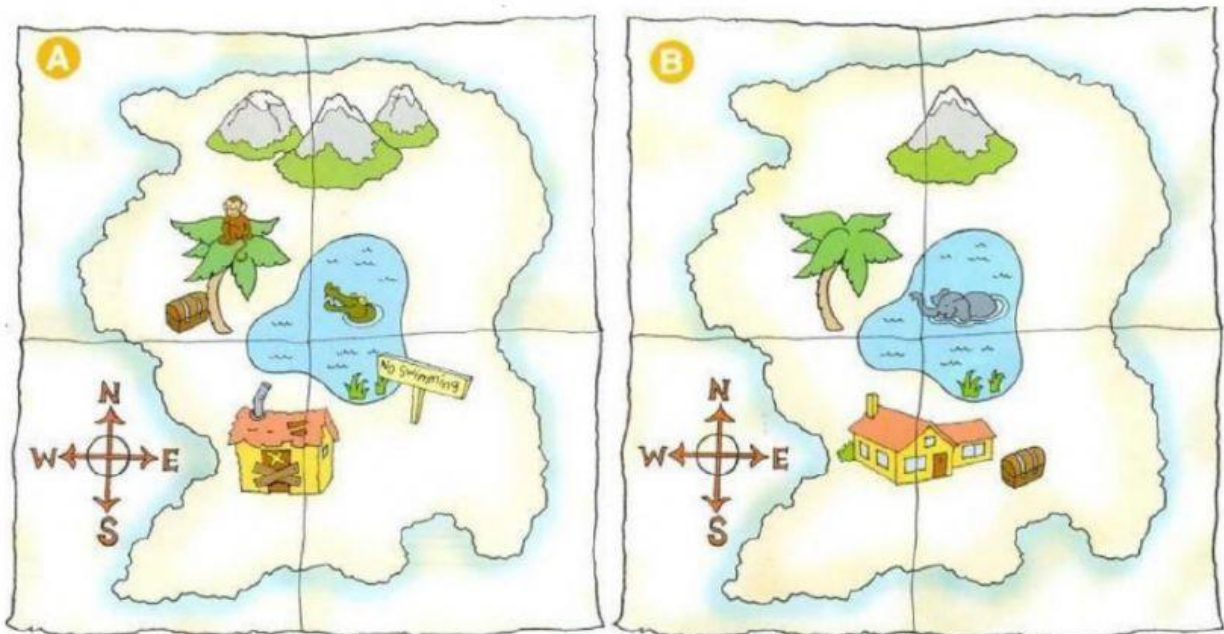

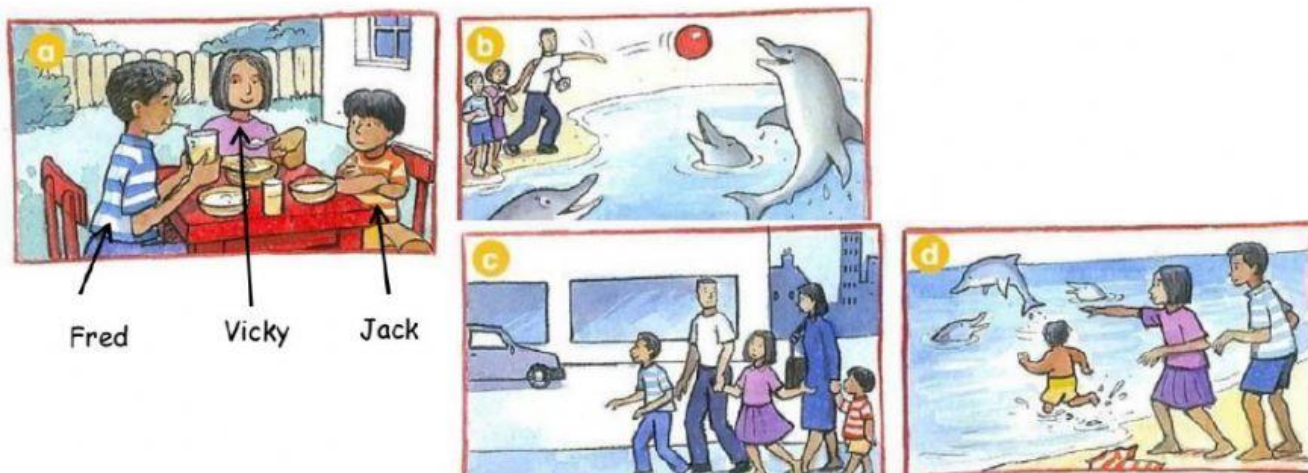

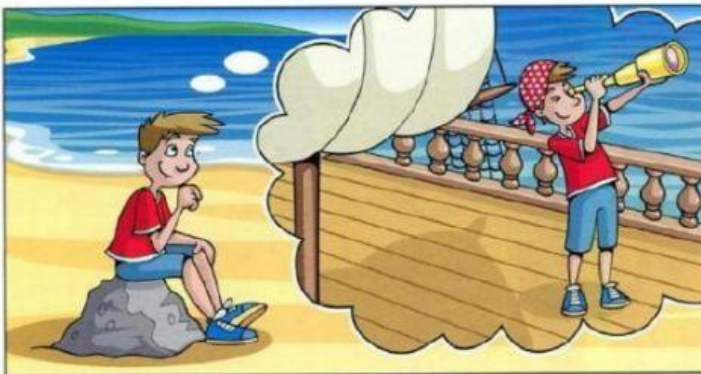

The Birthday Pirate



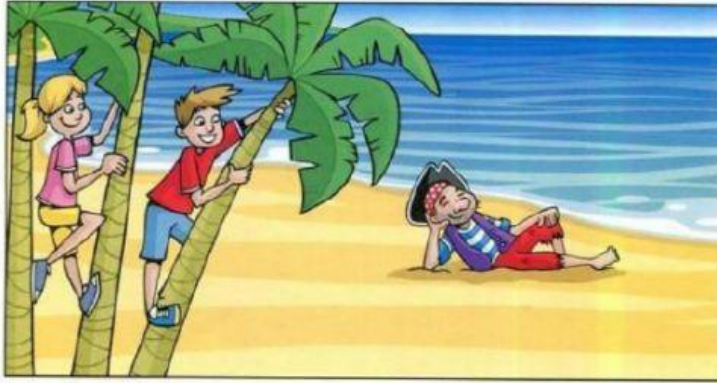
