1. Put a plastic bottle in your toilet tank.		
2. Collect rainwater for watering plants.		
3. Allow leaks in pipelines and water systems.

6. Keep the water flowing when washing the dishes.		
7. Throw garbage in rivers, seas, and other bodies of water.

10. Upgrade old shower devices with a more water-efficient model.		
11. Use a bucket of water and a dipper when taking a bath instead of a shower.		
12. Wash fruits and vegetables in a bowl with water.		
13. Turn on the faucet and let the water run when you brush your teeth and wash your face.		
14. Collect the water you use from rinsing fruits and vegetables in watering the plants.		
15. Water your lawn and garden early in the morning or late in the afternoon to prevent fast evaporation.
