Gilbert served 2 mugs of coffee to customers at one table. There were 18 ounces of coffee in each mug. How much coffee did he serve altogether?

The gas tank on Bob's car holds 45 liters. He used 6 liters of gasoline on Saturday. How much gasoline was left in the car?



Wendy had a 762ml jug. If she poured out 120ml into a glass. How much orange juice will be left in the jug?



One storage drum of water was filled with 190 liters of water. June used 82 liters of it to clean the family car. How much water was left in the storage drum?
