Focus on the subject:
Vargas Llosa is the performer)

Focus on the object:
La fiesta del chivo is the receiver (DO)



- 1) SIMPLE PRESENT : IS/ ARE + Vpast participle
- 2) SIMPLE PAST : WAS/ WERE + Vpast participle
- 3) PRESENT CONTINUOUS : IS/ARE BEING + Vpast participle
- 4) PAST CONTINUOUS : WAS/ WERE BEING + Vpast participle
- 5) PRESENT PERFECT : HAS/HAVE BEEN + Vpast participle
- 6) FUTURE : WILL + BE + Vpast participle
