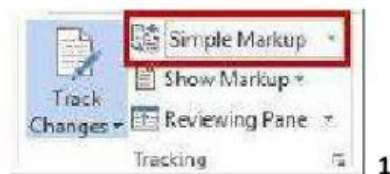


## Lesson 2      Reviewing your Document - Track Changes Part 2

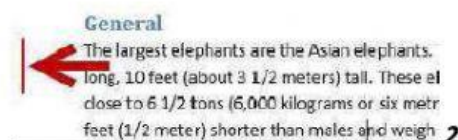
### Using the Simple Markup Display Settings

This setting will show you sections of your document that have had changes made to them as a red line in the left side margin. Comments will also be shown as a speech bubble in the right margin of your document. The changes will remain hidden until you click the red line, upon which the changes and comments will be made visible. You can toggle between view/hide these changes as necessary.

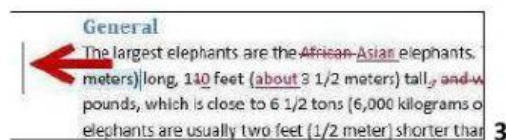
1. Ensure that *Simple Markup* has been selected as your *review display* (1).



2. *Red lines* will appear in the *left margin* of your document, indicating that a change has been made on this line (2).



3. Click the **red line** to show the changes made in your document. (3).



4. The **red line** will become *grey* and the changes in your document will become *visible*.

5. To *hide* changes again, click the **Grey line**.

### Activating the Reviewing Pane.

When active, the **Reviewing Pane** will display the number of revisions in the document, type of change made, and what was changed. You can also use the **Reviewing Pane** to quickly jump to revisions within your document by selecting them. To activate the **Reviewing Pane**.

1. In the **Ribbon**, click on the **Review** tab.
2. In the **Tracking** group, click on **Reviewing Pane**. (3)



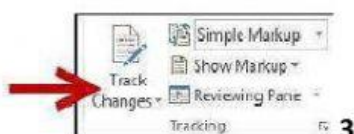
3. The **Reviewing Pane** will appear on the left side of your document.(4)



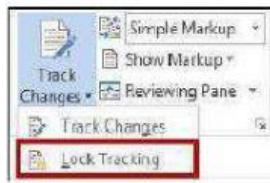
### Locking Track Changes

If you are collaborating on a document with users, and want to ensure that Track Changes is used, you can Lock Tracking so the tracking option cannot be turned off.

1. In the **Ribbon**, click on **Review** tab.
2. In the **Tracking** group, click on the **lower-half** of the **Track Changes** icon(3).



3. A dropdown list will appear. Click on **Lock Tracking** from the list.

4. The **Lock Tracking** window will appear. Set a *password* (if desired) and *click OK*. ( 4)

5. The document will now be locked to track changes. To remove this, follow steps 1-3 above (enter password if prompted).
