7 **Third**, another factor that is being affected by the pandemic is the social interaction with friends, classmates, colleagues, relatives, etc. 8 **Additionally**, lack of social interaction is affecting other aspects, 9 **especially** psychological and physical ones.

10 **In conclusion**, we have to think of taking some considerations carry out this process as good as possible, 11 **such as** minimize the distractions at home, organize times, have someone to talk to in case you have a crisis, have personal activities, do some exercise, eat and sleep properly. If you can do them and integrate them in your daily life gradually, it will be really helpful to overcome these difficult times.

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
