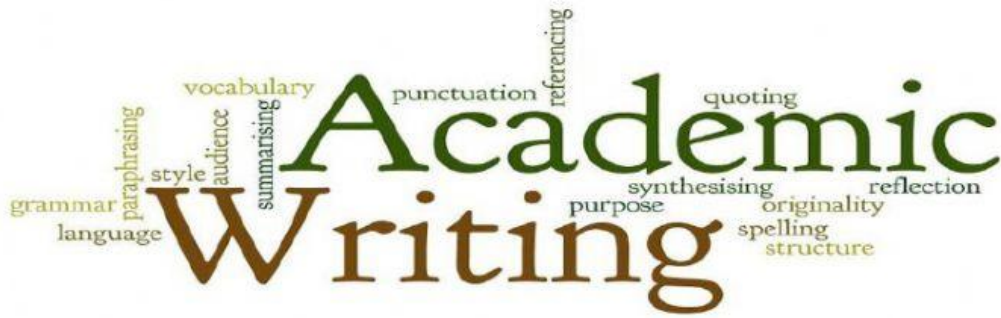




After watching the video, say if the following statements are true or false:
