Two firefighters killed in Argentina perfume shop blast

Two firefighters (DIE) and another fifteen ARE / WERE **wounded** after two explosions in a perfume shop in Buenos Aires on Tuesday as they were trying to **extinguish** a **blaze** (fire), the emergency services (SAY).

The **blasts**, the causes of which were being investigated, (CATCH) the firefighters by surprise in Villa Crespo, a middle class **neighborhood** in the center of the Argentine capital city.

"As we were picking up the fallen firefighters we were (CATCH) by the second explosion. " There IS / ARE two dead and 15 wounded," **Alberto Crescenti**, head of the emergency medical system, (TELL) news channel C5N.

The blaze, which **came** on the National Day of Voluntary Firefighters, (**TAKE**) the lives of Ariel Gastón Vázquez, 27, and Maximiliano Firma Paz, 43, officials later (**CONFIRM**).

Six of the **injured** were taken to hospitals by police helicopter. = A police helicopter took six of the **injured** to hospitals.

Perfumeries **IS / ARE** **among** the shops considered essential during the coronavirus **lockdown** in Buenos Aires, as they **SELL / SELLS** face masks, hand sanitizer, alcohol, bleach (lavandina) and more items .
