


DIFFERENT LANDFORMS

1. Plateau




a. A small piece of land with water all around it

2. Hill




b. An area of land that is higher than the land around it, but flat

3. Mountain




c. A tall piece of land, usually with steep sides

4. Lake




d. A line of water; can be curvy

5. River




e. Flat, open land

f. A small mound




7. Plain
