

Suffix

A suffix is a letter or a group of letters that is added at the end of a word.

Depending on whether it is a noun, verb, adjective or adverb, a different suffix would be required.

For example, the verb 'read' can be altered to become the noun 'reader' by adding the suffix- 'er'. The same verb can also be turned into the adjective 'readable' by adding the suffix- 'able'.

As an adjective, the suffix full means full of and as an adjective suffix less means without any.

Eg: Rohan takes his time and paints with care. He is a careful painter. His paintings are colourful.

Jimmy paints in a hurry. He is a careless painter and his paintings are colourless.

- bake + er = baker A baker is a person who bakes.
- bicycle + ist = bicyclist A bicyclist is a person who rides a bicycle.
