We use *adjectives* to describe difference between things.



| SIZE | |
|-----------|--------------|
| ADJECTIVE | COMPARATIVE |
| big | bigger than |
| tall | taller than |
| long | longer than |
| small | smaller than |
| short | shorter than |
| fat | fatter than |
| thin | thinner than |
| light | lighter than |
| heavy | heavier than |

England is **bigger** than Scotland.

Wales is **smaller** than Scotland.

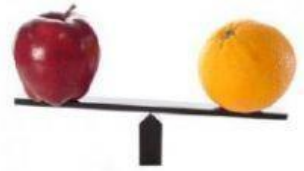

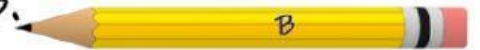
