Of Bumps and Bruises

Ouch! You bruised yourself again! Now you have a big red bump. How does this happen? Where we bruise ourselves, we break a small blood vessel called a capillary. Blood then fills the tissues under the skin. As more blood travels to the bruise, the bump gets bigger.

Most bruises disappear after two weeks. But they often change color first! After two days, your bruise turns blue or purple. By day six, it's green. And by the eighth and ninth, it looks yellow to light brown.
