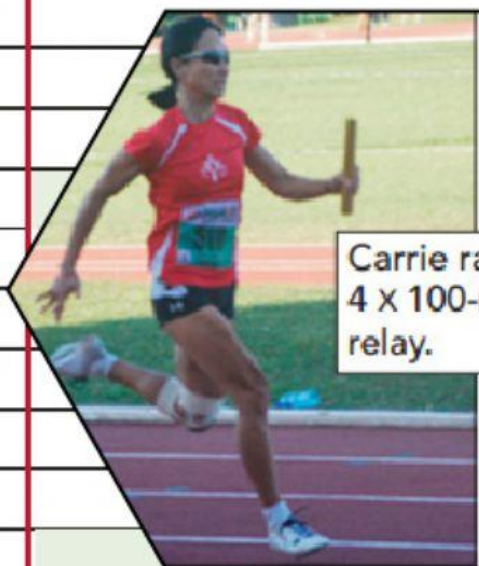

Carrie (win) a gold medal in the 200-metre race and a silver medal in the 100-metre race. She says, "When I compete, I always think about my new heart and the gift I (receive) from my donor."
