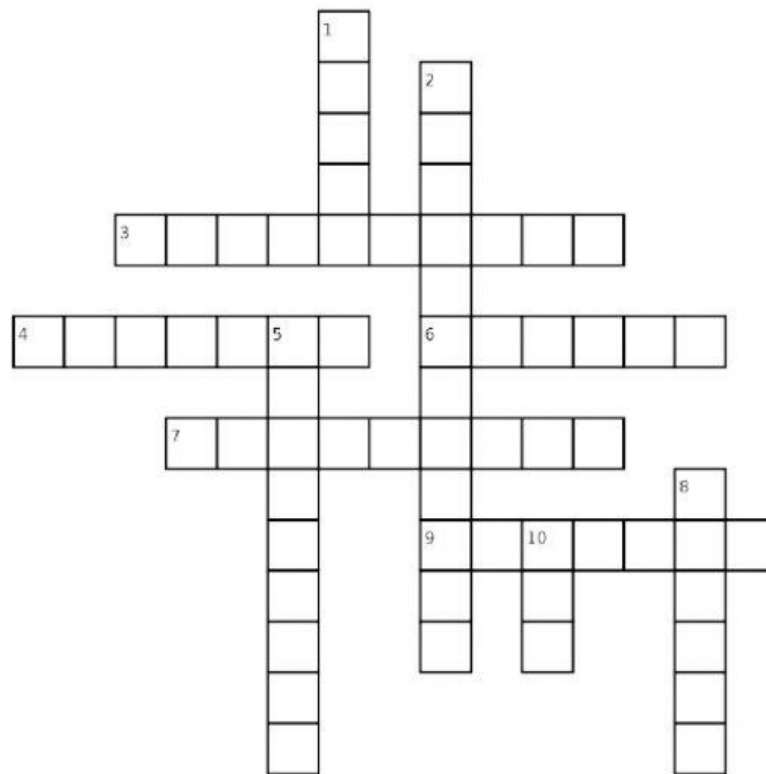


Northern Constellations Crossword Puzzle!



Down:

1. Also known as the Hunter; contains two of the ten brightest stars in the sky - Rigel (Beta Orionis) and Betelgeuse (Alpha Orionis).
2. Not considered a constellation; instead, it is the most visible part of the constellation, Ursa Major, the Great Bear.
5. Largest northern constellation; its name means the Great Bear.
8. One of the larger northern constellations; Name means "fish."
10. One of the largest constellations in the northern hemisphere; representing the lion.

Across:

3. Formed by three massive, bright stars located in our galaxy, in the direction of the constellation Orion, the Hunter.
4. Named after the winged horse in Greek mythology; one of the largest constellations.
6. Name means "the twins" in Latin.
7. Considered the Little Bear; constellation that the north star is located in.
9. Considered the north star.
