PRESENT SIMPLE (THIRD PERSON)

SUBJECT	HE	SHE	IT
?	Does he speak Spanish?		
+	He usually speaks English		
-	He doesn't speak French		
✓ X	Yes, he does/No, he doesn't

RULES

- Do every day/week/year
- Generally true
- Always happen
- Do/does->questions
- Don't/doesn't->negative sentences
- 3rd person

THEORY

ADVERBS OF FREQUENCY

- Adverbs: always, often, sometimes, usually, hardly ever, never...
- I am usually ill → After verb to be
- I usually study → Before verb rest of the verbs
- I never get ill → Always + verb

EXPRESSIONS OF FREQUENCY

- Usually at the end of a sentence (once a week, every day, twice a month...)
- At the end of a sentence
